

### Accessing 'Sketch Engine' – 'Word Sketch'

1. Go to Reading University **library** web page.
2. Click on '**E-resources**' (on your left), then go to '**Databases a-z**', and '**Sketch Engine**' (under the letter '**S**').
3. There are two links to access 'Sketch Engine': one when you are **on the university campus** and the other when you're **off the campus**. Because we are working in the classroom, please use the former.
4. Log on with your username and password.
5. Scroll down and click on **British Academic Written English Corpus** (BAWE).
6. From there click on '**Word Sketch**' that is on your left-hand side.
7. Type your keyword in the **lemma search box** (which requires you to provide only the basic form of word; e.g.: 'go' – not 'goes') and identify its **class** (part of speech) in the box below. Hit the search button.
8. Focus on the **categories** that are included in your task.
9. Check the use of your keywords in **Concordance** by clicking on numbers presented in blue.
10. **Have fun with it!**
