Post staff begin national strike

Vocab and Prediction

Students work on vocab and predict content. Open class FB with meanings and unconfirmed FB about the content of the story.

Students watch to see if their predictions were correct.

Listening for the Main Ideas /Summarising

Students discuss and try and answer before watching. Watch and discuss to come up with one line. Feedback & check. Clicks bring up suggested answers 1 by 1.

Discussion
